### School Council

The role of the School Council is to make sure that all pupils have their ideas and opinions heard by the staff including their views on some of the priorities in the School Development Plan. In the Autumn term the School Council conducted a survey to gather pupils' views on having fruit at break time. They worked collaboratively to collate the data and produce graphs showing the results. They then met with the head teacher to feedback the results and this work formed part of their presentation to pupils and families in the Christmas Assembly.

In the Spring term members of the School council met with the Parents' Group to talk to them about their role and how it related to the Rights of the Child.

The school council have interviewed teachers and teaching assistants who have applied for jobs at North Ridge High School and they are involved in promoting understanding of the articles outlined by the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child.
